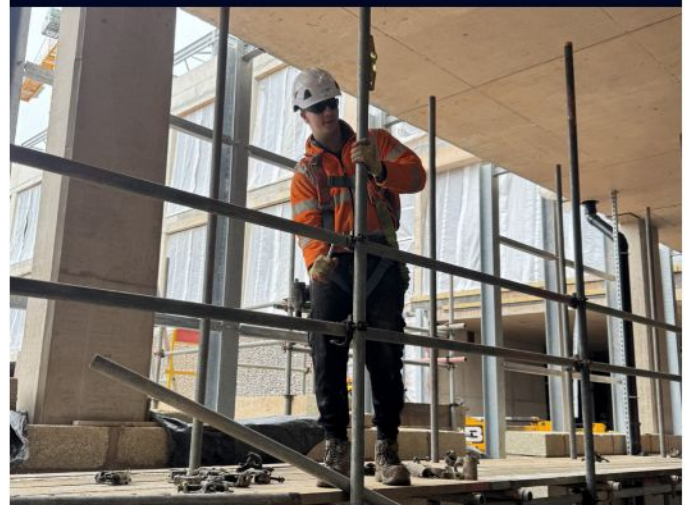
Spotlight Sarah-Jayne Parsons
